Learning Objectives

This course presents all the necessary information to relevant individuals to understand the work and structure of the Scientific and Technical Review Panel of the Convention on Wetlands and how it functions in a synthetized manner.

Panel members, focal points, and observers will gain all the necessary information to effectively support the fulfilment of the STRP's mandate throughout the current triennium. By the end of this training, you will have a comprehensive understanding of the responsibilities and expectations associated with your role

Content & Duration
