***Green Benches Program Support for the Supreme Court of Thailand and Thai Judiciary:
Development of Introductory Course International and National Environmental Law and
Governance for the Court of Justice of Thailand***

**I. Format of the Launch and Training Program for “Introductory Course on
International and National Environmental Law and Governance”**

The Launch and Training Program shall be co-hosted by JTI, USAID and UNEP. It will be a 5 half-day virtual event held online. Participants, overseas experts and presenters will be connected via zoom. The maximum number of participants will be 50 Thai judges, 8-10 trainers/facilitators, 10 organizing personnel JTI, UNEP, USAID Wildlife Asia. Simultaneous translation (Thai-English) will be provided.

Ideally the course would be 5 days of lessons (each lesson being 60-90 minutes and each tutorial being 90 minutes) and 2-3 days of field trip. Due to the recent COVID-19 outbreak in Thailand and, at the request of JTI, for the Launch and Inaugural Training program in May 2021, the lessons will be delivered virtually, and the field trip will be deferred. The course will be launched with a total duration of 5 half days. The field trip may be run later in 2021.

In this modified virtual agenda each lesson is delivered in 1 hour and each tutorial is given 30-45 minutes. Please see Annex I below for proposed agenda.

Participants will be given access to the Judicial Curriculum on UNEP’s InforMEA online platform prior to the meeting. Participants are encouraged to sign up and enroll for the course before the start of the training.
